Welcome Festival- Celebrating Harmony Day

Our annual Welcome Festival on Friday 18 March is fast approaching and we are looking for volunteers to assist us with the planning and coordination of this very special night. We will be celebrating our school's cultural diversity and wonderful community spirit by again hosting a vast array of cultural food stalls. This year we have a special treat for our students. We plan to provide all children with a special DEM Passport and have them travel the world (via the playground). Swimming Carnival – 23 February

Thanks to all families who have returned their swimming carnival notes and payment. As explained in last week's newsletter, due to the layout of North Sydney Pool and the steepness of the grandstand steps, the school's risk assessment has determined that students observing from the grandstand will be required to remain seated throughout the course of the carnival with the exception of when they are swimming in an event or taking toilet breaks. Due to this restriction, and based on the experiences of the past two years, it has been determined that this is an unrealistic and unfair expectation of non-swimmers and therefore the option of attending the carnival only as a spectator is not available in 2016. All students in Years 3-6 who remain at school will be participating in a range of sporting activities and tasks associated with the 2016 Olympics. As specified in the note, children participating in the carnival need to be able to swim 50 metres unaided.

If your child is in Years 2-6 and is unable to swim 50 metres unaided please be aware that the school runs a swim scheme program every year in Term 4 for non-swimmers in Years 2-6. The swim scheme program runs every morning for 2 weeks and focuses on developing essential swimming and water survival skills.

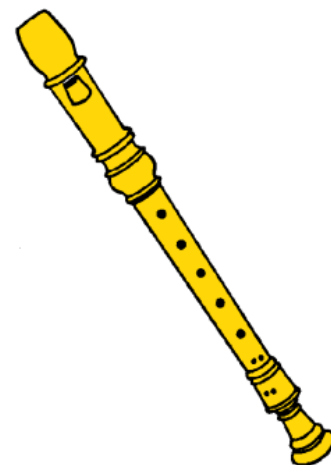

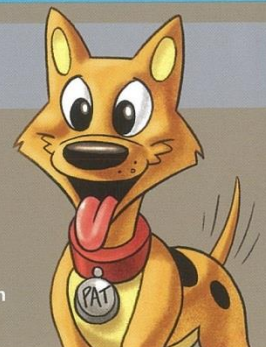

- 4 Are your children attending different schools? Tap the school selector,  select add a school, type the school name* into the search then add. Jump between your children's schools by touching the school name/logo in the top blue bar, or switch schools from the slide-in menu.

*Any additional schools will need to be licensed users of School Stream to appear in the app.

Choose what notifications you receive

- 1 Open the School Stream app on your mobile device
- 2 From the slide-in menu, go to Settings
- 3 Under Edit/Alerts select My Schools and select your School to open the Notifications page
- 4 Toggle notifications on or off individually (e.g. Alerts, Events, Newsletters, etc.)
- 5 When you have finished, use the Back button to return to the Settings page, then select Done to return to your School

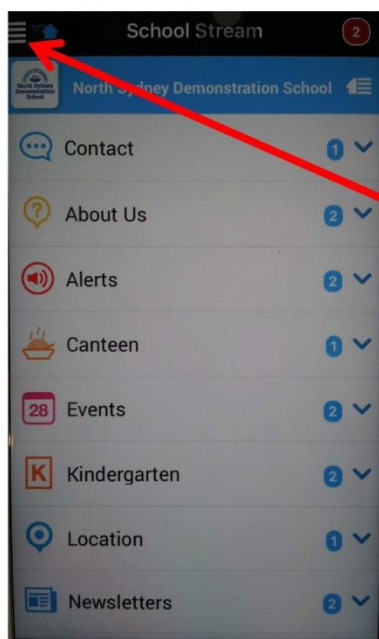

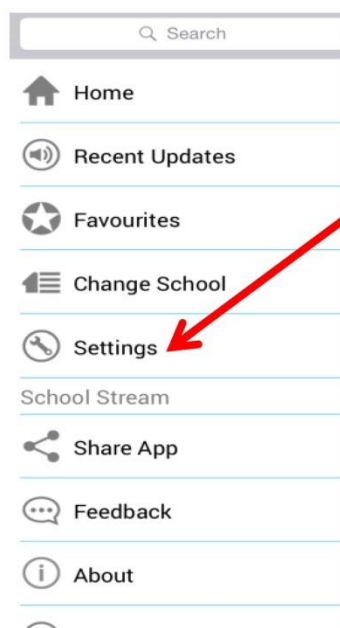

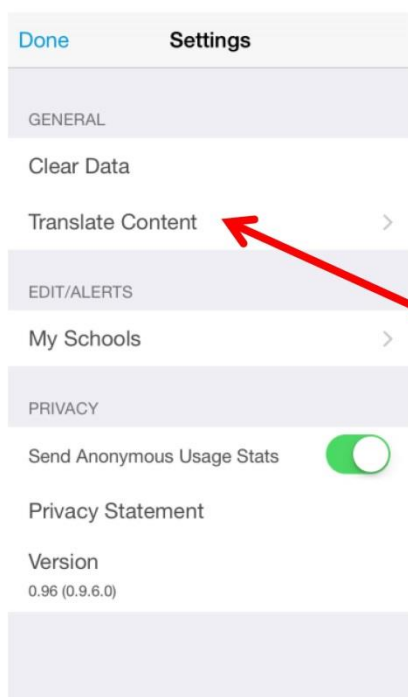
How to set your School Stream App to automatically translate into your chosen language...



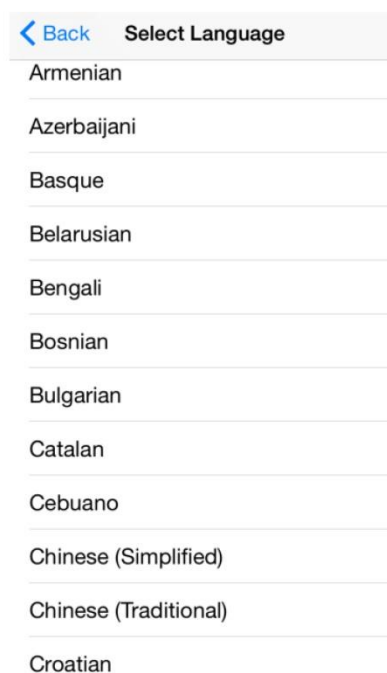
Step One:

Instructions for **installing & deleting** the School Stream app from your device

iPhone / iPad iOS 7.x - 8.x

Installing

1. From your mobile device go to the **App Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the **FREE** button to the right of the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Enter your Apple ID and password & tap **OK**
5. Wait for the install icon to change to **OPEN**
6. Tap the **OPEN** button
7. You will be prompted to accept push notifications, you will need to select **OK**
8. Start typing your **school name** into the search then **SELECT** your school

Deleting

1. From your device press and **hold down** the **School Stream icon** until the **icon begins to jiggle**.
2. Tap the **little x** in the **upper-left corner** of the School Stream app. (A dialog appears, informing you that deleting this app also deletes all its data).
3. Tap the **Delete button**.

Android/Tablet

Installing

1. From your mobile device go to the **Play Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Tap the **ACCEPT** button
5. Wait for the app to install then tap the **OPEN** button
6. Start typing your school name into the search then **SELECT** your school
7. Tap the **DONE** button in the top left

Deleting

1. Tap on the Menu button
2. Tap on **Settings: Applications: Manage applications**
3. Tap on the **School Stream app**
4. Tap on **Uninstall**



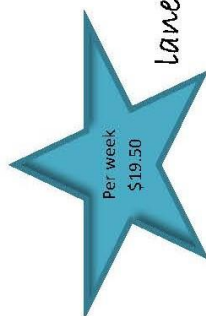
