Is English an additional language for you?

If English is not your first language and you would like support from the school with regards to communication please be aware of the following school initiatives:

- Isabella Kim has been appointed as our Community Engagement Officer for Semester One and will be available on Monday mornings this Term from 8:30- 9:30 a.m. outside the office to help those parents requiring assistance with forms or notes.
- An Information Evening will be held On Monday 7 March at 6:00pm in the School Library for parents who have English as an additional language. Information will be provided on the following topics:
 - Your child's English learning at school;
 - Supporting your child at home with English;
 - Getting help filling out notes and forms;
 - Communicating with teachers;
 - Bilingualism and language development;

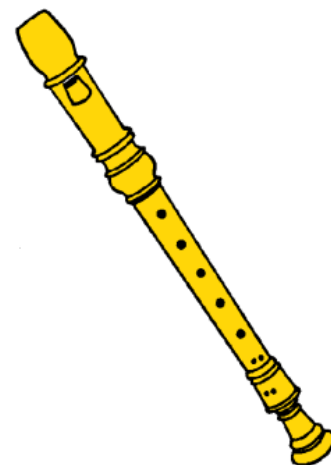

Library News

To Kindergarten Parents:

Your Kindergarten child has been visiting the school library to learn about routines and borrowing books. We have been spending time at school discussing library citizenship, personal interest and how to take care of a book.

Kindergarten children will be able to start borrowing from next Monday 29 February. Library borrowing days during lesson time are as follows:

Thursday – KAW, KHK, KHT, KSB

Friday – KEG, KKM

To All Parents:

The library is also open to all students for borrowing from 8:25am to 8:45am before school and from 2:55pm to 3:15pm after school on Monday to Friday during school Term.

All children need a bag to borrow as this protects the book and helps the student with organisation. We recommend the North Sydney Dem library bag but any bag is fine – e.g. a personalised bag, pillow slip or sturdy shopping bag.

Learning to read for a young child is a thrilling experience. You can foster this attitude by reading with your child and encouraging them to look at and enjoy books from early on in their education. Research has found good readers and writers are children who enjoy reading.

The first time of borrowing at school is an exciting moment for a young child. They experience a “grown up” feeling a being allowed to choose a book, bring it home and have the personal responsibility of properly caring for a book. Children who do not borrow are not fully participating in the lesson and often feel sad when they watch their peers make their weekly selection.

Please help your child to remember to return their book each week. They will then be allowed to borrow another. Please also help your child to find overdue or lost books (if this occurs) and return them to the library.

You can join the program by opening a Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account at any Commonwealth Bank branch, over the phone on 13 2221 or via NetBank if you are an existing customer with NetBank access. The child will receive their yellow wallet and can start banking.

Our school receives \$5 when a student makes their first ever School Banking deposit and 5% on every deposit made through the school.



School Banking at the Dem is every Thursday. Our kids really enjoy participating in the program. It is a fun, engaging way for young Australians to learn lifelong money-management skills.

- 3 Once School Stream has finished installing, open the app, **type your school name into the search** then select your school. For more detailed instructions go to schoolstream.com.au/download
- 4 Are your children attending different schools? Tap the school selector,  select add a school, type the school name* into the search then add. Jump between your children's schools by touching the school name/logo in the top blue bar, or switch schools from the slide-in menu.

*Any additional schools will need to be licensed users of School Stream to appear in the app.

Choose what notifications you receive

- 1 Open the School Stream app on your mobile device
- 2 From the slide-in menu, go to Settings
- 3 Under Edit/Alerts select My Schools and select your School to open the Notifications page
- 4 Toggle notifications on or off individually (e.g. Alerts, Events, Newsletters, etc.)
- 5 When you have finished, use the Back button to return to the Settings page, then select Done to return to your School

Return at any time to change the notifications you receive.

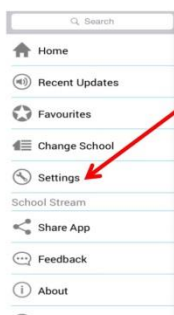

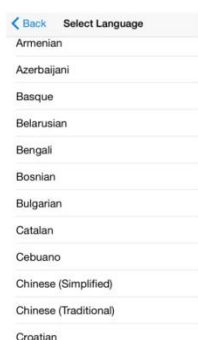

Instructions for **installing & deleting** the School Stream app from your device

iPhone / iPad iOS 7.x - 8.x

Installing

1. From your mobile device go to the **App Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the **FREE** button to the right of the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Enter your Apple ID and password & tap **OK**
5. Wait for the install icon to change to **OPEN**
6. Tap the **OPEN** button
7. You will be prompted to accept push notifications, you will need to select **OK**
8. Start typing your **school name** into the search, then **SELECT** your school

Deleting

1. From your device press and **hold down** the **School Stream icon** until the icon begins to jiggle.
2. Tap the little **x** in the upper-left corner of the School Stream app. (A dialog appears, informing you that deleting this app also deletes all its data).
3. Tap the **Delete** button.

Android/Tablet

Installing

1. From your mobile device go to the **Play Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Tap the **ACCEPT** button
5. Wait for the app to install then tap the **OPEN** button
6. Start typing your school name into the search then **SELECT** your school
7. Tap the **DONE** button in the top left

Deleting

1. Tap on the Menu button
2. Tap on **Settings: Applications: Manage applications**
3. Tap on the **School Stream app**
4. Tap on **Uninstall**

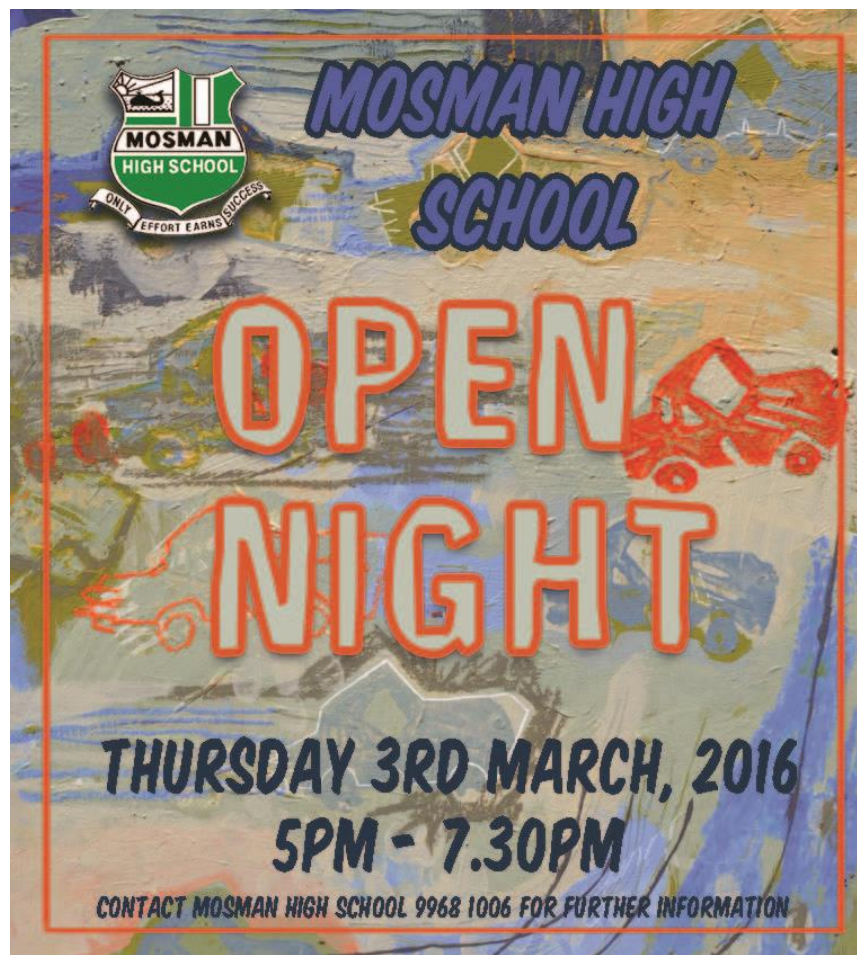

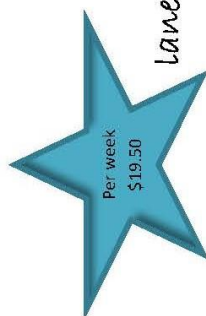
