Is English an additional language for you?

If English is not your first language and you would like support from the school with regards to communication please be aware of the following school initiatives:

- Isabella Kim has been appointed as our Community Engagement Officer for Semester One and will be available on Monday mornings this Term from 8:30- 9:30 a.m. outside the office to help those parents requiring assistance with forms or notes.
- An Information Evening will be held On Monday 7 March at 6:00pm in the School Library for parents who have English as an additional language. Information will be provided on the following topics:
 - Your child's English learning at school;
 - Supporting your child at home with English;
 - Getting help filling out notes and forms;
 - Communicating with teachers;
 - Bilingualism and language development;
 - Books in different languages in the school library.
- Translation is available in School Stream for parents whose first language is not English. You just need to select your language of choice in the Settings Option and School Stream will translate all of the custom content to help you navigate the app. Please see instructions on page 8 of this Newsletter for more detail. This option will not unfortunately translate any attachments.
- If you are fluent in both English and another language and you are able to translate notes for the school we would like to speak to you about coming to a mutually agreeable arrangement.

The theme for Harmony Day 2016 is 'our diversity is our strength'. It is a day to celebrate the vibrant cultures, races and religions that make up Australian society. It's about inclusiveness, respect and a sense of belonging for everyone. It is a day for all Australians to embrace cultural diversity and to share what we have in common.

DID YOU KNOW.....

- Around 45 per cent of Australians were born overseas or have at least one parent who was
- 85 per cent of Australians agree multiculturalism has been good for Australia
- People from over 200 countries make up the Australian community
- More than 300 languages are spoken in Australian homes; in our school we have students from 51 different languages backgrounds!
- Apart from English the most common languages spoken in Australia are Mandarin, Italian, Arabic, Cantonese, Greek, Vietnamese, Tagalog/Filipino, Spanish and Hindi
- More than 60 Indigenous languages are spoken in Australia
- 92 per cent of Australians feel a great sense of belonging to our country

On Harmony Day, students may come to school dressed in their national dress or that of another culture. Throughout the day there will be many activities taking place in classrooms such as storytelling, cultural performances, art, craft, blogging and music from around the world. We welcome parents and members of our community who are available to visit classes and share their stories with students.

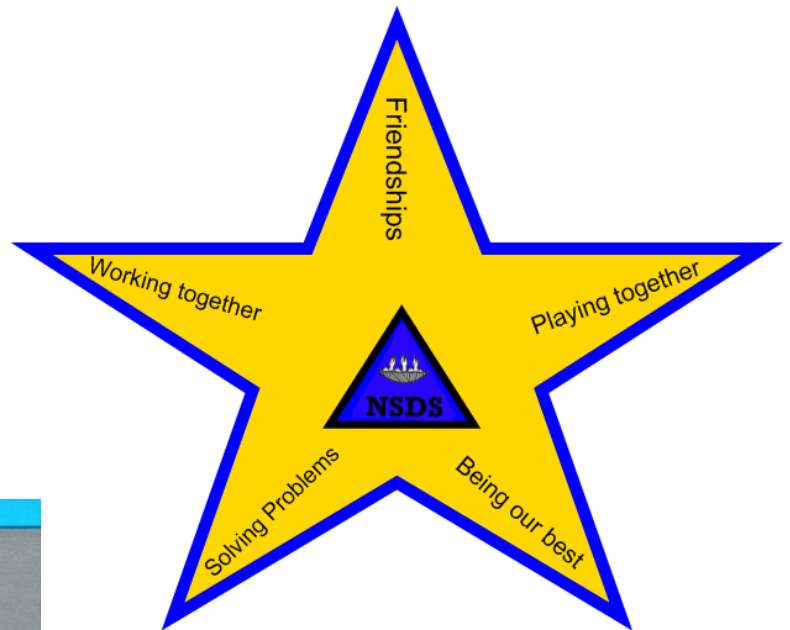

Besides the benefits and rewards for the students, we also earn a financial reward for the school. In 2015 we raised \$1,175.68. A big thank you to all of you! And a special thank you to the parents who have helped with School Banking at the Dem.

You can join the program by opening a Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account at any Commonwealth Bank branch, over the phone on 13 2221 or via NetBank if you are an existing customer with NetBank access. The child will receive their yellow wallet and can start banking.

Our school receives \$5 when a student makes their first ever School Banking deposit and 5% on every deposit made through the school.



School Banking at the Dem is every Thursday. Our kids really enjoy participating in the program. It is a fun, engaging way for young Australians to learn lifelong money-management skills.

How to get the School Stream app on your mobile device

1. From your mobile device go to the **App Store (iPhone/iPad)** or **Play Store (Android)**, search for **School Stream** and download the app to your phone.
2. Make sure you agree to **push notifications**
3. Once School Stream has finished installing, open the app, **type your school name into the search** then select your school. For more detailed instructions go to **schoolstream.com.au/download**
4. Are your children attending different schools? Tap the school selector,  select add a school, type the school name* into the search then add. Jump between your children's schools by touching the school name/logo in the top blue bar, or switch schools from the slide-in menu.

*Any additional schools will need to be licensed users of School Stream to appear in the app.

Choose what notifications you receive

1. Open the School Stream app on your mobile device
2. From the slide-in menu, go to Settings
3. Under Edit/Alerts select My Schools and select your School to open the Notifications page
4. Toggle notifications on or off individually (e.g. Alerts, Events, Newsletters, etc.)
5. When you have finished, use the Back button to return to the Settings page, then select Done to return to your School

Return at any time to change the notifications you receive.

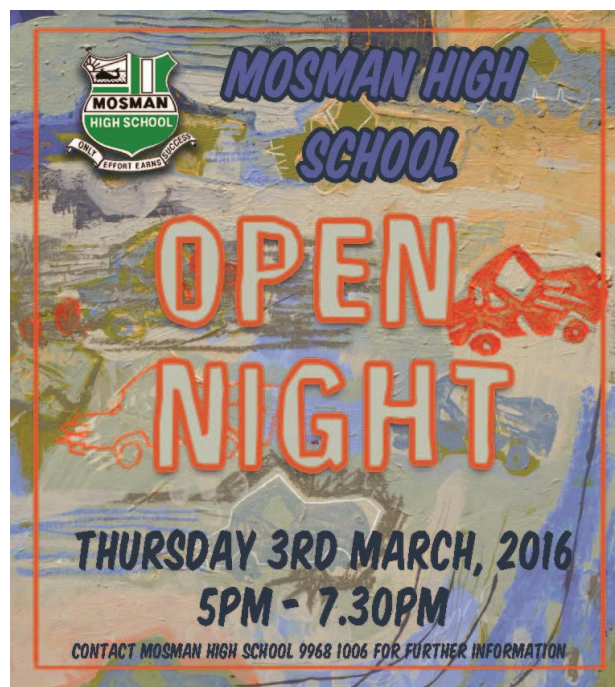
