### End of Year Festival

If you have received a missed call from the school, please check your voicemail messages before calling the school so you can let the office know where to direct your call.

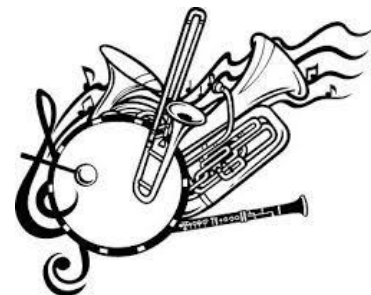
## Spare clothes for school
