Sports Presentation Ceremony

Congratulations to Matilda (in Year 6) and Dylan (in Year 4) who were awarded this year's Sportspersons of the Year awards at Monday's Sports Presentation Ceremony. Both Matilda and Dylan have had many sporting successes this year in their chosen fields. No doubt we will be hearing more about them in years to come as they continue to pursue their love of sport.

Matilda's achievements this year include:

- At the North Shore Zone Swimming Carnival she came 1st in the 11 years 50m freestyle, 1st in the 50m breaststroke, 2nd in the senior Individual Medley, 4th in the 50m backstroke, 1st in the 50m butterfly, 2nd in the open 100m freestyle and 2nd in the 4x50m relay.
- At the Zone athletics carnival she came 3rd in the Discus, 4th in the shot put, 10th in the high jump, 15th in the 200m and 26th in the 100m.
- At the Sydney North Regional Swimming carnival she came 9th in the 50m butterfly, 10th in the open 100m freestyle, 11th in the 50m freestyle, 14th in the senior Individual Medley and 16th in the 50m breaststroke.
- She was both the school and zone age champion for swimming this year.
- Outside of school she has competed at the NSW short and long course championships in 50m butterfly, 50m freestyle and relays. She has already qualified for next year's state swimming championships in 50m freestyle and butterfly. She holds club records for the 200m and 400m freestyle for her age group.
- She is also the school record holder for the 8's and 9's high jump, 8's, 9's and 10's discus in athletics and the 10's and 11's 50m freestyle in swimming.

Dylan's achievements include:

- At the North Shore Zone Swimming Carnival he came 1st in the 9 years 50m freestyle, 1st in the junior butterfly, 2nd in the junior breaststroke, 3rd in the junior backstroke, 6th in the 4x50 relay and 12th in the open 100m freestyle.
- At the Sydney North Regional Swimming Carnival he came 1st in the 9 years 50m freestyle and 13th in the junior breaststroke.
- At the NSWPSA State Swimming Carnival he came 2nd in the 9 years 50m freestyle and as a member of the combined Sydney North 5x50 relay team he won gold. He didn't continue and represent NSW at the national championships for the 50m freestyle because there is no national championship for 9 year olds.
- He is our school's current record holder in the 8's and 9's 50m freestyle and the junior 50m butterfly.
- Outside of school Dylan has competed at the Ginninderra Short Course Championships at the AIS where he placed 2nd in both the junior 50m and 100m freestyle. He competed at the NSW metropolitan and NSW short course championships. At the Metro North East championships, Dylan came 1st in the junior 100m backstroke, 2nd in the junior 100m freestyle and 100m breaststroke, and 3rd in the junior 50m freestyle.

Pictured below are our two Sportspersons of the Year and the two students who received special recognition for their overall sporting achievements.



The two students who received special recognition based on their continued success in a range of school sports this year are:

- Tilly (in Year 6) has been a consistently excellent athlete during her time at the Dem. This year she qualified for and competed in all four Zone Carnivals, Track, Field, Cross Country and Swimming. Coming first in the 800m, 4th in the 200m, 8th in the 100m and 10th in high jump at the Zone athletics carnival. She came 2nd in the Zone cross country. At the Zone swimming carnival she came 2nd in the 4x50m freestyle relay, 4th in the 50m butterfly and 7th in the 50m backstroke. She then went on to represent our North Shore Zone at the Sydney North Swimming carnival in the 4x50m relay, the SN Cross country carnival and came third in the 800m at the SN athletics carnival. At the NSW PSSA State athletics carnival she placed 22nd in the 800m. Outside of school sport she has also represented her Little Athletics club at the state carnival in the 800m. To even further demonstrate her all round ability, she is a member of the Sydney Swans academy.
- Sofia (in Year 6) has been an outstanding athlete, particularly in the sprints, over her years at the Dem. This year at the Zone athletics carnival she came 1st in the 100m, 1st in the 200m, 1st in the long jump, 4th in the high jump and 6th in the 800m. At the Sydney North regional athletics carnival she came 1st in the 100m, 2nd in the 200m and 10th in the long jump. At the NSW PSSA State carnival she came 15th in the 100m and 20th in the 200m. With Little Athletics she came 1st in the 100m and 3rd in the 200m at their regional carnivals and made the final in both these events at the State Carnival. She is also the holder of the 200m record for u11 girls at the Mosman Little A's club as well as the school record holder for the 100m for 10's and 11's, the 200m for 11's and the 11 years high jump.

There are also a number of students who deserve a mention based on their successes this year.

- Maya Husdell placed 1st and Cillian Guy placed 3rd at the Jiu Jitsu national championships.
- Ben Coates came third in the NSW State Series and Max Wright placed 8th in the NSW Championship series for BMX.
- Michelle Yang was selected for the NSWPSA team to play in the National Championships where her team placed 2nd.
- Zahara Chu competed in State gymnastics as well being a consistently high achiever in Cross Country and qualifying for Zone Carnivals.
- Ned Howell was selected for the 9's SAP North Shore Mariners program.
- Tully Howell has been selected in the competitive program at the Lane Cove Gymnastics Club to compete in the State Competitions.
- Mia Cassar was selected in the Regional T-Ball development squad
- Lirra Conybeare-Yamaguchi is the 10 year girls champion at the Willoughby Swim Club and has set a number of records.
- Havana van Wyk was in the Zone basketball team and captained her Division 1 representative team to 3rd at the NSW state championship.
- Joel Turton was a member of the North Sydney Academy soccer team at the Kanga Cup in Canberra where they played against NSW and international teams. He made every Zone carnival this year.
- Stian Constable has played representative cricket and soccer for the North Shore and North Sydney United.
- James Mitchell competed at the North East Metropolitan Zone Carnival for the 100m and 400m for Little Athletics.
- Olivia Miller was selected to play at the Sydney Swans Academy.
- Lucinda Perry's basketball team came first in the under 11's Bankstown Championships.

What a list of Dem achievers! Well done to our awards recipients and thank you to parents & carers for being able to attend in support of your child(ren). A special thank you to Mr Hearnshaw and Mr Grimmond who collated all the student sporting achievements and organised our Sports Presentation Assembly.
