What to expect on Day 1, 2019

Students going into Years 1 to 6 next year will arrive at school and go to their 2018 classrooms. From here students will be placed into their new classes sometime during the morning session, after they have had time to catch up with their friends. Children will be able to update parents on their new classrooms and teachers at the end of the day.

Kindergarten 2019

Next year we are excited to welcome 155 Kindergarten students to the Dem. Before they start school, new Kindergarten students will undertake a Best Start Assessment (BSA), a compulsory individual 40-minute assessment for all new Kindergarten students. **BSAs will be held on Wednesday 30 January, Thursday 31 January and Friday 1 February, 2019 and Kindergarten students should only come to school for their allocated BSA time.**

On Monday 4 February 2019 Kindergarten students will have staggered start times to allow them time to settle in. Please come to the Hall where children will be directed to their new classroom. As it is an important milestone in your own and your child's life, we encourage parents/carers to plan to have the morning free to allow for a smooth transition.

For more detailed information regarding your child's Best Start Assessment time and first-day at school time please refer to the email that has been sent to all new Kindergarten parents. If you have not received an email, please contact the school office on 9955 2822.

Some important dates to note:

- **The first day of school for students in Years 1 – 6 is Wednesday 30 January 2019.** (Please note that Monday 28 January is the Australia Day Public Holiday and Tuesday 29 January is a pupil free day.)
- **Kindergarten Best Start Assessments (BSAs) are being held from 30 January to 1 February 2019.**
- **The first day of school for students starting Kindergarten is Monday 4 February 2019.**
- The school office will be open during the holidays to process new enrolments for K-6 on **Tuesday 22 January 2019** from 9am to 12noon.
- The uniform shop will be open additional hours from **Tuesday 29 January to Friday 1 February 2019** at 8:30 – 9:30am and 2:30 – 4:00pm.

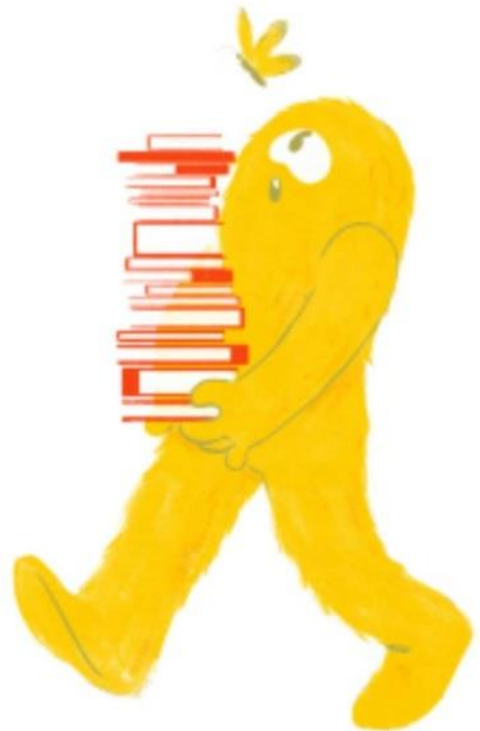

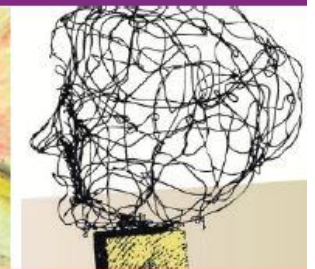

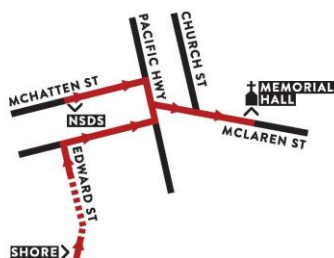
