Swim Scheme Program in Term 4

North Sydney Dem will again be participating in the Department of Education's Swim Scheme program which focuses on children in Years 2-6 who are not yet confident swimmers and are unable to swim 25m unaided. An Expression of Interest note has been sent home this week for your consideration and is due for return to the school by Wednesday 26 September. Please see a copy of the EOI note on page 5 of this newsletter. Swim Scheme will only be opened up to other students (i.e. students who are already strong swimmers) if there are spaces available. Swim Scheme will take place for two weeks from Monday 26 November through to Friday 7 December.

- Monday 12 November 2018 – Application for entry closes;
- Thursday 14 March 2019 – Students will be required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test.

Expression of Interest – Swim Scheme 2018

Dear Parents and Carers,

Students from North Sydney Demonstration School have the opportunity to participate in a learn-to-swim program at North Sydney Pool from **Monday 26th November – Friday 7th December (inclusively)**.

The Department of Education Swimming Scheme has been planned to supplement the Personal Development, Health and Physical Education curriculum undertaken in all classrooms. Students in Years 2 – 6 who have not achieved a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills and are unable to confidently swim 25m unaided in deep water are eligible to participate in the school swimming scheme.


It is very important that Expression of Interest notes are returned by Wednesday 26 September and please note that returning this Expression of Interest does not guarantee your child a position in the program.

Students will travel by bus to and from North Sydney Pool each day. The cost of Swim Scheme will be confirmed once final numbers are received. (Last year, the cost of swim scheme was \$95.) If your child is offered a place in swim scheme, this cost will appear on your Term 4 Statement of Account and must be paid prior to **Monday 19 November**. If payment is not received by this date then your child's place may be offered to another on the reserve list.

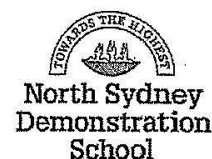

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

The final rehearsal and performance for the Festival of Choral Music is next **Monday, 24 September** at the Sydney Opera House. We will be catching the train at approximately 11:15am from Waverton Station. Students must meet Ms Rawson & Ms Payne in 5RR at the end of recess (10:35am) on the day.

Students must wear performance black pants/skirt to school and a black t-shirt. The performance t-shirt will be given out at school on the day. Please see the specific dress requirements below. Students must bring a bottle of water and their lunch in a paper bag (no other bags please).

The rehearsal will finish at approximately 4:00pm and **students will not be returning to school**. Parents must collect their child from the meeting point at the Sydney Opera House by 4:15pm, provide them with an early dinner (see attached map). **There will be no supervision from 4:15pm – 6:15pm, all students must be collected by an adult by 4:15pm.**

Students must meet Ms Rawson & Ms Payne outside the Sydney Opera House at **6:15pm** at the same meeting point (see map). Your child must be there on time as all performers must be seated and ready to perform prior to the concert commencing at 7:00pm sharp.

At the end of the concert parents are required to collect their child from the Opera House at the meeting place indicated on the attached map. **There will be no transport organised through the school for children following the concert. All children must have private transport home.** The concert will conclude at approximately 9.30pm.

Students must wear their performance shirt (provided on the day), black shoes, black pants/skirt, and black socks/stockings.

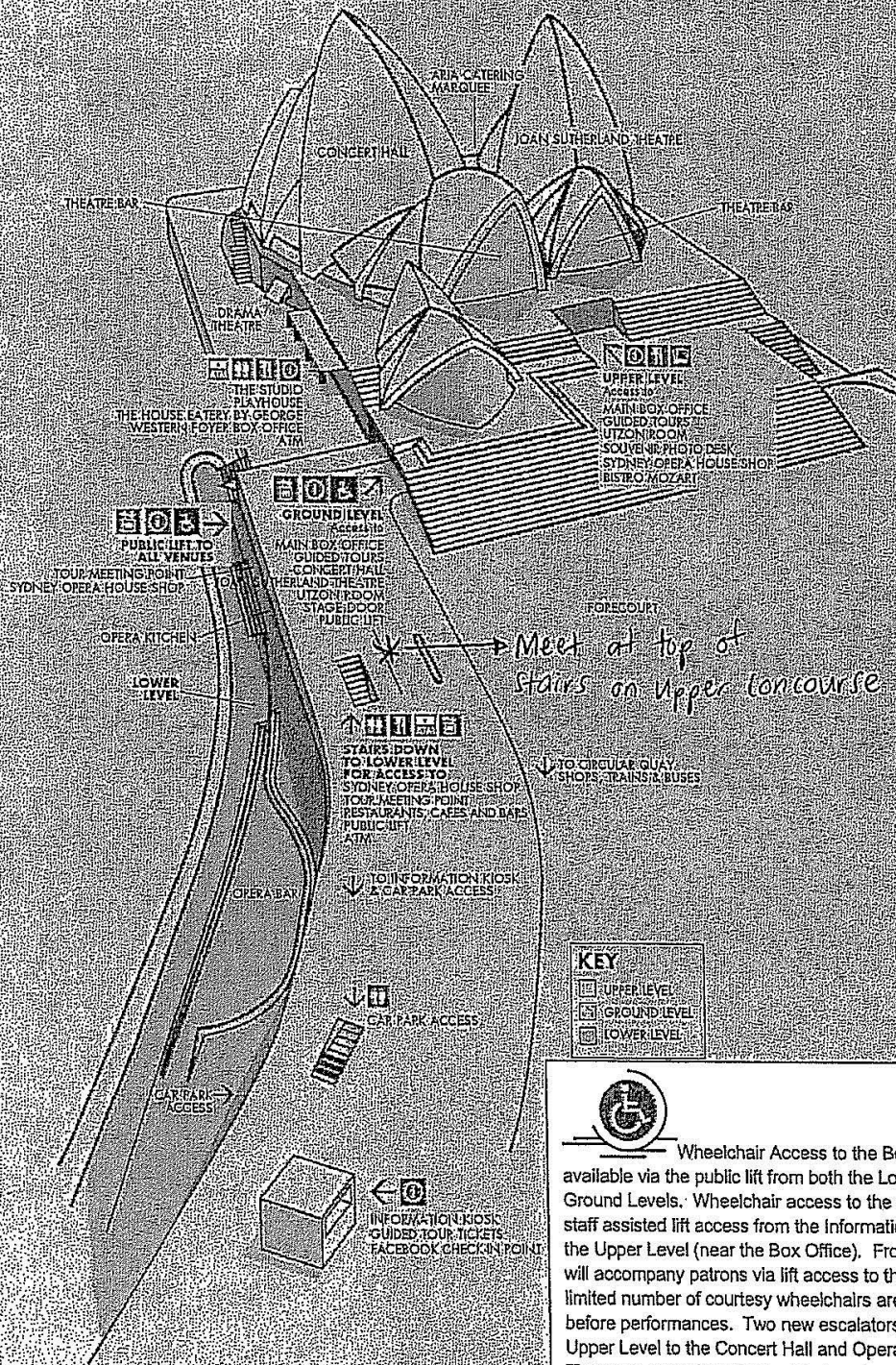

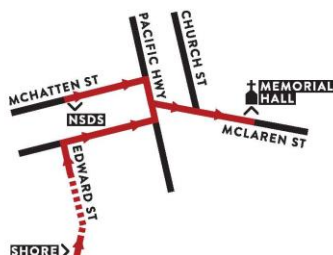
