Meet the Teacher Nights

Meet the Teacher nights will be held next week as follows:

Grade newsletters will be uploaded to the website and School Stream by Monday for your information. They may answer many questions you have or could inspire new questions. Please note that **Meet the Teacher Night** is an informal event and is not intended to be an opportunity for you to discuss your child and their needs. Such information is very important to us and therefore needs to be conveyed in a 1:1 meeting between you and your child's teacher. Your child's teacher will have their diary with them on the night and can make an appointment for you to meet at a more convenient time. Supervision before and after school

A reminder to all parents and carers that the school day starts at 8:55am and ends at 2:55pm. Students are not permitted to be on the school premises before 8:25am as there is no teacher supervision before 8:25am, and all students must be collected by 2:55pm at bell time.

If you would like to stay at school with your child after this time please ensure that your child stays in the top playground, that they have a Stay and Play wrist band, and that they are within your line of sight. A teacher will be on duty until 3:15pm ensuring that all students have been collected and to call parents who have not arrived on time.

If you have an older child at high school that is coming to collect a younger sibling, they must arrive at the school in time for the 2:55pm bell. If they are not able to be on site by this time, then alternative arrangements must be made for the younger sibling. KU Children's Services and North Sydney Council provide after school care and the school has a number of other external providers who provide extra-curricular activities on site each afternoon. Please see a list of after-school activities on page 11 of this newsletter. All students must be collected at 2:55pm each day.

Swimming Carnival – Tuesday 19 February

Permission notes for this year's Swimming Carnival were sent home with all students in Years 3 to 6 and students in Year 2 who are turning 8 in 2019. Notes are due for return next Tuesday, 12 February. The swimming carnival will be held on Tuesday 19 February at North Sydney Pool. As has been the case for the last two years, the carnival is open for students who wish to participate in events. Students who do not wish to swim will remain at school and will participate in a range of sporting activities and sport related tasks.

As is specified in the permission note, children participating in the carnival **must be able to swim 50 metres unaided**. If you have not seen your child swim 50 metres they probably can't. Please ensure that you have personally witnessed your child's swimming ability prior to ticking the box that states they can swim 50 metres.

If your child is in Years 2-6 and is **unable** to swim 50 metres unaided please be aware that the school runs a swim scheme program every year in Term 4 for non-swimmers in Years 2-6. The swim scheme program runs every morning for 2 weeks and focuses on developing essential swimming and water survival skills.

Scripture Program

Scripture and Ethics classes will commence on **Wednesday 20 February**. Your child will be placed in the scripture, non-scripture or Ethics group nominated by you at the time of enrolment dependent on the availability of scripture and Ethics teachers. In the event that a teacher is unavailable your child will attend non-scripture where they will read, complete homework or engage in activities that revise already taught concepts. Students will not be able to change scripture classes without a valid reason being provided by their parent. Unfortunately, due to large student numbers, the sampling of multiple scripture classes throughout the year is not possible and due to limited Ethics teachers, students not already in an Ethics class (moving from 2018 to 2019) will need to go on a waitlist.

Physical Activity and Wellbeing Program – NEW in 2019

In 2019 North Sydney Demonstration School have engaged *Sport in Schools Australia* to assist us with the delivery of two important programs.

The programs are; **Personalised learning for high achievement**; and **Physical Activity and Wellbeing for students**.

Throughout the year, your child will participate in 120 minutes per fortnight of specialised instruction in the areas of: athletics, gymnastics, fundamental movement skills, dance, wellbeing and sports development led by fully trained Physical Education teachers. This program will ensure that all students achieve their mandated 120 minutes per week of school based physical activity and that important physical skills are developed.

During the time that your child is engaging in these lessons, their teacher will be participating in 120 minutes of professional learning in the areas of digital technologies, English, maths, wellbeing and science. The focus of this professional learning will be to ensure that your child's teacher has the relevant skills and the required time to deliver quality instruction in the areas most pertinent to your child's success.

The Physical Activity and Wellbeing Program will appear as a cost of \$45 on each term's Statement of Account. The program is significantly subsidised out of the school's quality teaching, literacy and numeracy funds.

Thank you for supporting the school in ensuring that we provide high quality instruction for your child in all areas of the curriculum.

National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence

The National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence is held on Friday 15 March. To reinforce the message against bullying, this year our students will be participating in an Antibullying Incursion with Brainstorm Productions who use theatre performances to help students understand and reduce the incidences of bullying in schools and improve behaviour and wellbeing.

On Friday 22 February, Students in K-3 will participate in 'The Protectors' program focusing on Bullying, eSafety and Resilience, and on Friday 1 March, Students in Years 4 -6 will participate in the 'Saving Lil and Archie' program focusing on Positive Behaviours, Bullying and eSafety.

ICAS 2019

In 2019 students in Years 2-6 will once again have the opportunity to participate in ICAS testing. ICAS is an independent, skills-based assessment program. It is not compulsory and the results are not part of the North Sydney Demonstration School assessment program. ICAS is run by the University of NSW. You can find out more about ICAS via this link: <https://www.eaa.unsw.edu.au/icas/about>

In 2019 NSDS will be conducting each of the ICAS tests after school hours during September. We expect that the tests will be completed by approximately 4:30pm on the specified dates. Children will be supervised by NSDS teachers. Please refer to page 8 for more information about the dates of each test and details on how to register. All registrations need to be submitted and paid for by **Friday 29 March. No late registrations will be accepted.**

New Bell Times in 2019

To allow more peer mentoring and whole school programs in 2019, all students will adhere to one playground timetable. The times are as follows:

Students will eat lunch at 10:55am – 11:05am with a 20min play till 11:25am and they will then have a crunch-n-sip snack at 1:25pm – 1:35pm with an extended play time till 2:15pm.

Students in K-2 will continue to play in separate playgrounds from students in Years 3-6. The exception to this rule is students wishing to play in the Bay Road Playground. This playground has been zoned a shared playground where students will be supported by staff in engaging in appropriate peer mentoring activities.

Paper bag lunch orders are collected in the classroom at the beginning of the school day and delivered to the tuckshop. The Tuckshop will still be open for small snack purchases at both break times.

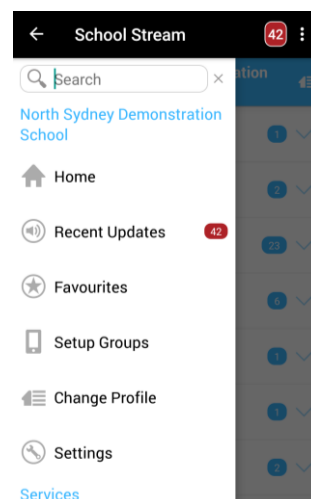
Food Allergies at the Dem

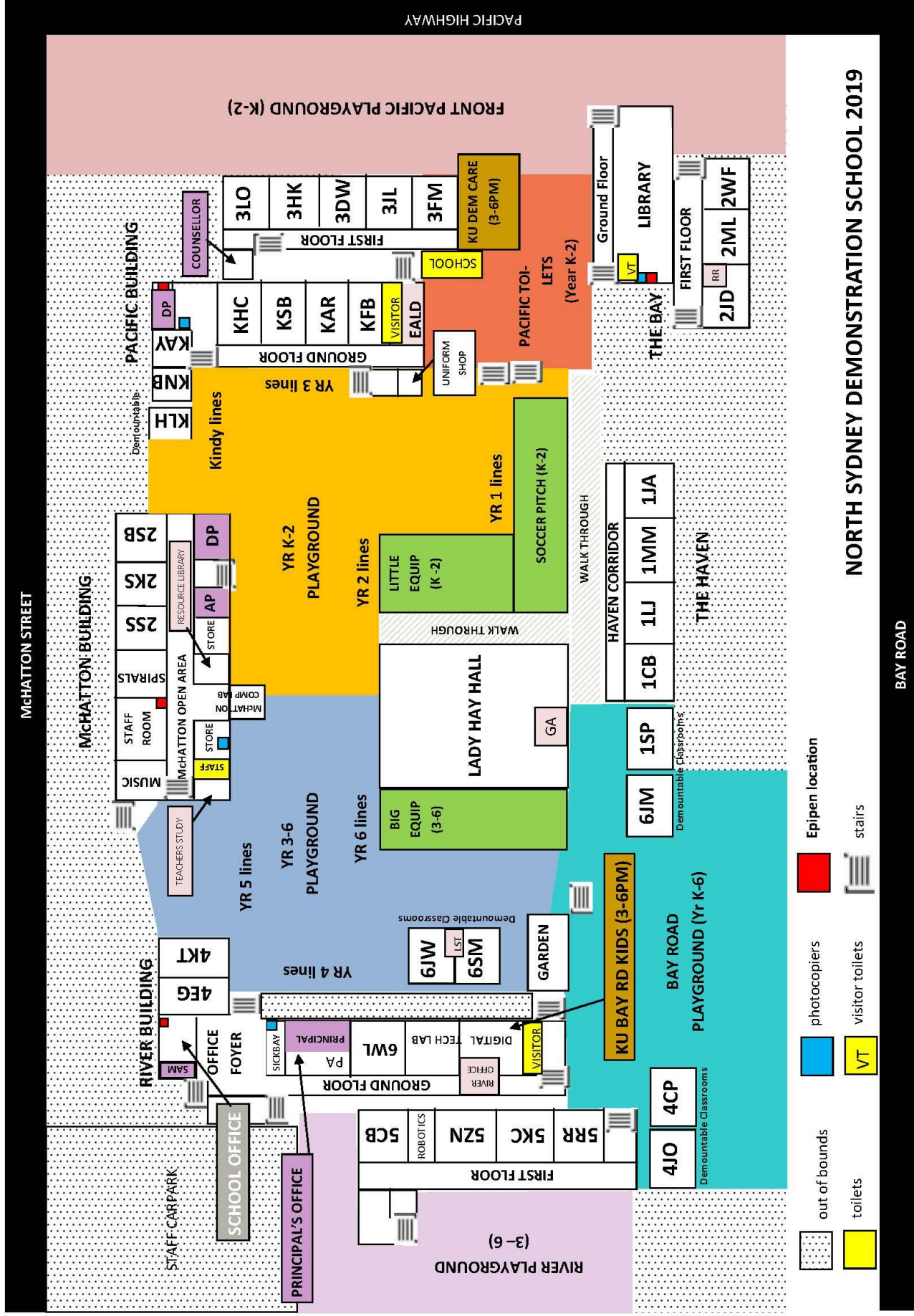
If you are using the School Stream App but are not receiving notifications for your child's grade, you may need to update your notification options, using the following steps.

Casual Work

School Crossing Supervisors – Work with your community 1 x Casual position – North Sydney Local Government Area (00006SLY)

An important person in a child's school life is the School Crossing Supervisor, who ensures they cross the road safely. The role requires minimal hours out of your day and gives something worthwhile back to the community.

The hours are usually 8:00am to 9:30am and/or 2:30pm to 4:00pm Monday to Friday during school terms. You may be required to work morning, afternoon, both shifts and no shifts. As a casual you will be filling in for existing part-time staff and on call basis as required. The base rate is \$23.02 – \$27.62 per hour.

All the qualifications you need are community spirit, good communication skills, an alert and professional attitude to work and a reliable personality. The casual hours and school holidays would suit a parent or grandparent, a retiree or anyone wanting meaningful work — but not full-time.

Training for your key responsibilities of directing traffic to stop at the designated crossing and giving clear instructions to infants and primary school students to cross the road safely, will be provided. You may be required to attend a health assessment. Appointment is subject to a Working with Children Check clearance.

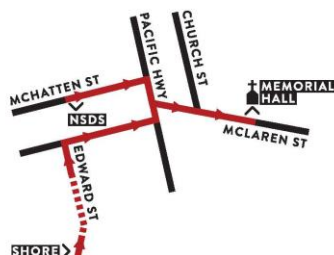
