Power Upgrade

As part of their Science and Technology conceptual focus on living things, Kindergarten have thoroughly enjoyed looking after their brood of chicks during the Henny Penny Hatching program over the last two weeks. Students have watched some of the eggs hatch and were amazed by how tired the brand new baby chicks were. Classes observed and held the chicks each day and it was wonderful to see how responsible and gentle our Kindergarten students were as they became more



confident with handling.

There were lots of changes noticed as the chicks started to grow and the students learned about keeping the chicks healthy by looking after their daily needs for food, water, clean bedding and warmth.

The chicks will be missed by Kindergarten students and teachers alike but we are looking forward to the next step in the Science program as Kindergarten students get ready to design their own model chicken shelters.

The Council is conducting a survey to determine if there is support to retain existing restrictions or introduce additional metered and/or timed parking restrictions. The survey will assist in determining support for the parking restrictions proposed in these streets.

The survey is available to complete online and will close on Sunday 16 June. Results of the survey will be considered by the North Sydney Traffic Committee on Friday 26 July.

NORTH SYDNEY DEMOSTRATION SCHOOL – NEW SUBSTATION INSTALLATION

TOBCO has been engaged to undertake the upgrade of the Ausgrid Electrical Network, which includes the installation of a new kiosk substation on the school premises in McHatton Street, North Sydney. The works consists of excavating and installation of electrical conduit, laying new conduits, installation of High Voltage and Low Voltage Cables and temporarily reinstating the disturbed areas.

We will be undertaking Night works this Thursday (06/06/2019) and Friday (07/06/2019) to finish the remainder of the trenching in McHatton Street and Bay Road, respectively. The works areas will be barricaded off and pedestrian/traffic management will be in place. There will be minimal noise during these works.

Our construction team will be in constant communication throughout the project to minimise disruptions or affects to your building/business. The workers will have noise blankets around the machinery used to minimise the impact on receivers during the works, and high impact noises (such as excavator hammering and demolition saws) will be used early in the shift (prior to 11:00pm) to minimise effect on surrounds.

For reference, we have included the following shifts required to be completed during night shift in the coming weeks. There is a map on the reverse of this letter to provide clear indication of work zones on the nights noted below:

- Thursday Night 06/06/2019 – Excavation works, McHatton St Footpath adjacent to School Fence. High impact noise completed before 11:00pm
- Friday Night 07/06/2019 – Excavation works, Bay Road Footpath adjacent to School Fence. High impact noise completed before 11:00pm
- Thursday Night 13/06/2019 – Contingency Shift if above shifts are adversely affected eg weather conditions. Another letter drop will be completed if this shift is required.
- Friday Night 14/06/2019 – Cable Installation. No high noise impact on this evening. Work areas will be both McHatton St and Bay Road, North Sydney

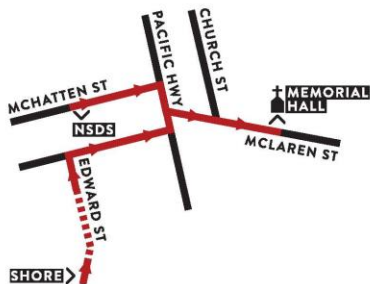

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
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
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
