External Validation

NSW public schools are committed to the pursuit of excellence and the provision of high quality educational opportunities for each and every child.

[The School Excellence Framework](#) (SEF), supports all NSW public schools in their pursuit of excellence by providing a clear description of the key elements of high quality practice across the three domains of learning, teaching and leading. Each year, schools assess their practices against the Framework to inform their school plans and annual school reports. The description of excellence in the Framework supports schools as they engage their communities in the development of a shared vision, the identification of strategic priorities, and the ongoing tracking of progress towards them.

Schools undergo an external validation of the evidence of their school self-assessment once every five-year cycle. Schools engage in discussions with an external panel and have their self-assessments validated. The panel, comprising of a Principal School Leadership (PSL) and a peer principal, meet with the school leadership team and determine whether the school's evidence supports their self-assessment using each element of the SEF. For each element a school will be validated as achieving at one of three levels: **Delivering, Sustaining and growing or Excelling.**

Last week, executive from North Sydney Demonstration School met with an external panel to discuss our self-assessment of the school's practices and the evidence that supported this assessment.

We are proud to report that the school has been validated as achieving at the top two levels in all areas of the school excellence framework.

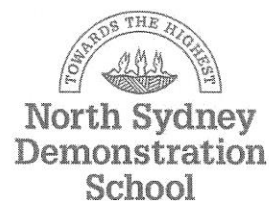

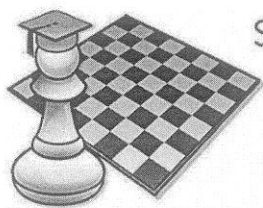

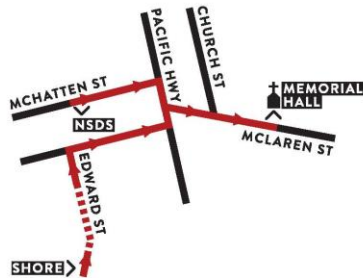
