Parliament and Civics Education Rebate (PACER)

This week, Year 6 students undertook an educational tour of the national capital where they had the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy. The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist the cost of this excursion, the Australian Government contributes funding of \$20.00 per students under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion and was used to subsidise the cost of transport and additional staff attending.

Students are always excited to attend this three day camp and this year was no different. Read below to find out what our campers enjoyed about this week's trip. Year 6 Canberra Camp

On Monday to Wednesday this week, Year 6 traveled to Canberra for our camp to learn all about the history of our capital city and have some fun on the way. In Parliament House we learnt about the 'green' House of Reps and the 'red' House of the Senate. We got to experience the roles in the House of Reps in an exciting role play! "Say WOW!"

Next we visited the High Court of Australia and the guide explained how the constitution was formed. Did you know that any coin in Australia with 2019 on it was made in the last month in the room we saw in the Royal Australian Mint? Movie Night! On the first night all of Year 6 went to the cinemas to watch 'Toy Story 4'.

When we looked at the view on Mount Ainslie we saw the War Memorial, where we saw recreated scenes of World War 2, followed by Anzac Parade and on the other side of the river Parliament House. Beautiful art adorned the walls at the National Gallery and even some painting by Monet. In the Museum we learnt about the past of farming and agriculture. And last but not least the highlight of our trip was Questacon! In this interactive science playground, where lightning had been recreated, everyone that tried the free-fall slide experience safely had the feeling of free-falling down a slide with an adrenaline rush.

In the end everyone learnt something and had a memorable trip!

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

The 2019 NSDS K-6 Track Carnival has been rescheduled from Term 2 and will now be held on **Monday 19 August at St Leonards Park (North Sydney Oval No. 2)**.

As previously advised, students will walk to and from the track events under the supervision of teachers.

Students in Years 2-6 will leave school at 9.15am and commence the first event at approximately 9.30am. These students will return to school by 2.55pm.

Students in Kindy and Year 1 will leave school at 11.50am, after lunch and commence novelty events at 12.15pm. These students will leave St Leonards Park to be back at school for power break.

Children are required to wear clothing in their house colour, and will need to bring the following with them:

- lunch & drinking water and snacks for the day (food purchasing is not available at the oval)
- suitable running shoes, a hat and sunscreen

All staff in attendance are responsible for first aid. Your child's teacher can advise your child of their sporting house if they have forgotten.
